Loyola University Chicago's Joan and Bill Hank Center for the Catholic Intellectual Heritage (CCIH) encourages the development of undergraduate and graduate courses concerned with or connected to the broad range of Catholic thought. It does this by offering full-time Loyola faculty a stipend of up to \$4,000 (pre-tax) to those who develop their courses during the summer. A call for applications goes out in the middle of the fall semester and are due in January. Applications are reviewed and evaluated by the CCIH Advisory Board. Applications are judged on the merits of the proposal and so on.
