







6. How to make distinctions between proprietary work and public sociology

Departmental reviewers must determine whether or not proprietary work can be included as research and research outcomes, e.g. an evaluation or marketing report. In cases where reviewers cannot review work not appropriate for inclusion in a hire and promotion portfolio in cases where all or part of the data, research instruments, and/or outcomes can be reviewed (albeit with some locational or respondent data identifiers suppressed for confidentiality purposes) such research is appropriate in the review of public scholarship.
