David Enlow, hailed for his *enormous virtuds; *(Stuttgarter Zeitung) and his *gutsy, yet sensitive performance* (arg Canada) is a concert and church musician who has performed across the nited States, in Canada, and across England and Europe. Mr. Enlow*s recentording of the complete major organ works of César Franck on the Pro Ongalabel, Pater Saphicus, has been described as *masterful*, *thrilling*assionate*, and *utterly compelling*.

Mr. Enlow is Organist and Choir Mastertbé Church of the Resurrection in New

Certification, serving as an examiner of organistationwide. His choir at the Church of the Resurrection performs over fifty mass settings each season, often with orchestra.

Mr. Enlow holds both a bachelores and a master's degreen The Juilliard School were he studied with Paul Jacobs and John Weaver. He also studied at the Cursisture of Music in Philadelphia, and with John Tuttle in Toronto.

David is a Fellow of the American Guild of Organistis, ner of the S. Lewis Elmer & Fellowship prizes, and an Associate of the Royal Canadian College of Organistis, ner of the Barker Prize. He has also won several national performance competition first prizes including ose of the Arthur Poister Competition and the Albert Schweitzer Organ Festival USA.
