Peter Morey (MM, AAGO) is an emerging sacred musician and Organ of Saint Luke's Epscopal Church in Evanstorllinois. There, he performs on the parish's beautifully restored 1922NE. Skinner Organ, Op. 327. One of the Organ Historical Society's E. Power Biggs Scholars, Class of 2020, he holds a Master of Music in Sacred Music from East Caro ina University. Like his greatgrandmother, Hazel Morey, he received the Associate certification from the American Guild of Organists.

A latecomer to the organ, Morey began his studies with Donald Sutherland while pursuing a Bachelor of Music in Oboe at the Peabody Institute of the Johns Hopkins University. During his time there, he was the recipient of the Harold Randolph Prize in Performance, and can be heard playing English Horn on Peabody's CD of works by Kevin Puts, conducted by Marin Alsop and released by NAXOS.

Following a lifechanging summer as Organ Scholar for the Royal School of Church Music course in Charlotte, NC, Morey was named the first Organ & Choirmaster Fellow at Christ Church, Raleigh. For three years he served as the Cathee Jean Huber Organ Scholar at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Greenville, NC while studying for the Massof Music in Sacred Music at East Carolina University. There, he held the Clay J.H. Endo ved Organ Scholarship and was inducted into Pi Kappa Lambda, the Music
