Robin Lovin is Director of Research at the Center of Theological Inquiry in Princeton, New Jersey and Cary M. Maguire University Professor of Ethics emeritus at SMU, where he taught moral theology across different disciplines from 2001-2012. Previously, he served eight years as dean of Perkins School of Theology. He is the author of numerous books and papers, including most recently *An Introduction to Christian Ethics: Goals, Duties, and Virtues* (2011), *Christian Realism and the New Realities* (2008) and *Christian Ethics: An Essential Guide* (1999).
